This document is to clarify the agreement for supervision requested by the above Supervisee, for the purpose of improving clinical skills in the diagnosis and treatment of sexual dysfunction, disorders and concerns. Upon completion of the agreed upon hours of supervision, those supervisory hours accrued will be submitted for consideration toward certification as a Sex Therapist by the American Association of Sexuality Educators, Counselors, and Therapists. **This agreement for supervision is not a guarantee or assurance of certification.** The Supervisee is responsible for identifying and meeting any additional certification requirements. The supervisor is available to assist in this process.

The Supervisee will present to the AASECT Certified Sex Therapist Supervisor the following documents: A copy of current CV, copy of current state licensure with expiration date, a copy of current liability insurance and proof of current membership in AASECT.

The AASECT Certified Supervisor will present to the Supervisee current AASECT Sex Therapist Supervisor Certification certificate, a current copy of state licensure with expiration date, and copy of current malpractice insurance.

Both parties agree to keep the above documents current and active throughout the entire supervision process. If either party fails to keep these documents current, we agree to inform the other party immediately and in writing.

Supervision will consist of face-to-face meetings either individually or in group supervision no less than 1 or 2 times per month, two hours for individual or four hours for group. We will/may also utilize consultation via SKYPE when necessary. The supervision consists of case discussion and review, reading appropriate materials, and clinical observation of the Supervisee by the Supervisor. Supervisee will see clients in his/her/hir professional office. Supervision will occur either in the Supervisee's office or in the Supervisor's office.

It will be the Supervisee's responsibility to maintain a case log during the course of supervision. The log will contain the date, type of case, client's age, gender, marital/relationship status, DSM-IV codes and the modality of therapy used. The Supervisor will keep a similar log. The Supervisee is expected to abide by

the ethical codes of his/her/hir profession and by the AAASECT ethical code. Failure to do so can result in termination of the supervision contract and any certifications achieved.

The Supervisor also agrees to abide by the ethics of her/his/hir profession and by the AAASECT ethical code and to follow the standards outlined by AAASECT for supervisory responsibilities.

The charge for the supervisory services is \$ _____ an hour for individual supervision and \$ _____ per session for group. To be reviewed in 20_____.

The supervision contract may be terminated by either party with thirty (30) days' notice for any reason.
