This document is to clarify the agreement with the AASECT Certified Sexuality Counselor Supervisor named above and the supervisee named above for the purpose of improving supervisory skills in the area of human sexuality counseling. Upon completion of the agreed upon hours of supervision, those supervision hours accrued will be submitted for consideration toward certification as a Sexuality Counselor by the American Association of Sexuality Educators, Counselors and Therapists. **This agreement for supervision is not a guarantee or assurance of certification.** The supervisee is responsible for identifying and meeting any additional certification requirements. The AASECT Certified Sexuality Counselor or Therapist Supervisor is available to assist in this process.

Supervision will consist of individual, face-to-face meetings, no less than once a month for no less than two (2) hours, for a period to extend over a minimum of twelve (12) months. The supervision sessions consist of discussion and review of treatment plans, counseling techniques, and counseling practice, as well as observation of the supervisee's counseling practice. Electronic technology such as Skype, videotapes, audiotapes, email and telephone may be used to facilitate the supervision process. The supervisor may change this schedule to meet the needs of the individual supervisee.

The Supervisee will present to the AASECT Certified Sex Counselor Supervisor the following documents: A copy of current CV, copy of current state licensure with expiration date, and a copy of current liability insurance and proof of current membership in AASECT.

The AASECT Certified Supervisor will present to the Supervisee current AASECT Sex Counselor Supervisor Certification certificate, a current copy of state licensure with expiration date, and copy of current malpractice insurance.

Both parties agree to keep the above documents current and active throughout the entire supervision process. If either party fails to keep these documents current, we agree to inform the other party immediately and in writing.

It will be the supervisee's responsibility to maintain a log during the course of supervision. The log will contain the date, time and content of supervision sessions. The log will also contain information related to the counseling practice which has been observed by or discussed with the Supervisor. The Supervisor will keep a similar log.

The supervisee is expected to abide by the ethical codes of their profession and by the AASECT ethical code. Failure to do so can result in termination of the supervision contract and any certifications achieved. The Supervisor also agrees to abide by the ethical codes of their profession and by the AASECT ethical code and to follow the standards outlined by AASECT for supervision responsibilities.

The supervision contract may be terminated by either party with thirty (30) days' notice for any reason.
